Greetings my brothers in Christ Jesus! I was blessed to be able to be in the nation where God called me to serve. My burden and passion to arrive is greater than ever before.

Thank you so much for your faithful support of my ministry; I know that many of you have been praying for me diligently, and God has certainly answered many of my prayer request. One of those answered prayer is that I was able to **lead six souls to Christ** of which one was during a missions conference in January, and four during the Dominican trip. On the left is a picture of Beбето and me. Beбето is a Haitian that I led to Christ during Saturday visitation with Salisbury Baptist Temple. He showed up to church that very Sunday morning and evening service to publicly profess his conversion.



Another answered prayer is that God added new supporter. I had **six new churches take me on for support** in the past two months. Two of which voted to take me on for support at the end of their service after presenting and preaching. What a blessing that was! I was able to be in **12 different churches** in the northeast, in **one missions conference**, and preached in a two day winter camp in New Jersey. God has also added many meetings to my calendar this year. By God's grace, **I am currently receiving 19% of the support needed.**



Lastly, I was able to take a trip to the Dominican Republic for 12 days and God just worked in my heart tremendously. I was able to spend some time with missionaries on the field, see their work and the nationals' churches, and be involved in their churches through preaching, teaching in their junior church, and soul-winning. When I left the country, I
