We are currently assisting the Jordan Family and the Wesson Family in Iglesia Bautista el Faro in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic until our housing situation is finished Lord willing by November. We have been able to help in Teen Sunday School, Soul winning visitation, preaching during different services, ladies meeting, men's retreat, and also had the opportunity to preach in Iglesia Bautista la Verdad under missionary Erik

Johnson. Pastor Johnson's church is about two hours north of Santo Domingo and they had their anniversary service. That day one soul accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and savior. Also, later that afternoon, I went to the park to play catch with pastor Johnson and we saw a young man sitting on the bench watching us as we played and talked. We asked him if he wanted to play with us and he said, loved to. After playing some baseball with that young man, I was able to preach the gospel to him and he accepted the Lord that afternoon as his savior.
