We hope this letter finds you well and enjoying the blessings of the Lord. It is a joy for us to write this prayer letter and share the things that the Lord has done for us in the last couple of weeks.

God came through an adverse situation

On January 3rd, together with the Pape family, we moved to Nagua. Things that day didn't go the way as planned. The moving truck was too tall and there was no way it was going to make it to the house without tearing down the power lines. We bought some long sticks, attached a broom head to it, and walked alongside the truck pushing the power lines up as much as possible until the truck arrived at a place where it couldn't continue any longer. We parked the truck two blocks away and just began to unload and carry all the items with the help of a church van from Missionary Eric Johnson. The neighbors were furious, yelling at us the whole time. We did our best to explain to them that we weren't trying to tear down the lines, but they didn't seem to understand. We praise the Lord that no damage was done to the power lines and we were able to unload all our belongings late that night. On many different occasions that day, the Lord showed us that His hand was with us. We know that if it hadn't been for that we probably would still be unloading our belongings from the truck today!

A Reminder to Share the Gospel.

A Few days after we moved, a group from Bible Baptist Church in Arkansas came to visit the Pape family and they went out with us to pass out tracks. We were able to distribute 2,500 tracks that day. Also, several people came to many of us and expressed excitement and interest in visiting the church plant.

The 3rd Wednesday of the month, my wife and I saw many vehicles on their way to the cemetery for a funeral. As we saw their sad faces and their sorrow, we couldn't help but think: Where is that soul today? What is the eternal destination of those that are carrying that body to the grave? We don't know but we are almost certain that it isn't heaven. The Lord has used this to remind us of the reason why we are here. Keeping fresh the truth to our hearts that these people one day are going to stand before God and that they need to be saved. We must tell them.

We would like to ask you to continue to pray for us as we continue to labor and prepare for things to come: Pray for the salvation of those we encounter, for a place where we can start the church, and for the kids Bible Club we are scheduling to start on February 3rd.
