Many people had to order trucks of water but we praise the Lord for the rain he has recently provided.

During the month of May, we carried out different activities in the ministry in Nagua and one of them was the activity for the mothers of our church on the last Friday of the month. Mother's Day here is celebrated every year on the last Sunday of the month; and this year, we decided to have a more intimate Mother's Day activity in our home with our church moms and daughters. In this activity, we had an attendance of 10 people: 4 mothers and 6 daughters (Two of which visited us for the first time). My wife Pamela Polanco had beautiful decorations, spent time getting to know the mothers and daughters, played a few games, prepared some delicious cupcakes, gave away a few gifts, and shared a great lesson on, "what kind of cupcake are you." We praise the Lord for all the moms and daughters that came. They had a great time and enjoyed themselves.
